

DISCLOSURE PURSUANT TO EU REGULATION 2016/679 (GDPR) ("REGULATION") AND CURRENT NATIONAL LEGISLATION

The Sguardi Altrove association takes into consideration the protection of personal data with which it comes into contact during its activity, and processes it in full compliance with the applicable time-to-time regulations (including, by way of example and not exhaustive, EU Regulation 2016/679, Legislative Decree no. 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree no. 101/2018, and the provisions issued by the Guarantor Authority for the Protection of Personal Data).

This information according to EU Regulation 2016/679 (after "Regulation" or the "GDPR") and of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003, as amended by Legislative Decree no.101/2018 (hereinafter the "Privacy Code") is intended for those (hereinafter the "interested" and, individually, the "Interested" and/or the "Participants"), who participate in the Call for Virtual Reality Artists initiative promoted as part of Sguardi Altrove Women's International Film Festival, aimed at selecting works in virtual reality.

1. THE OWNER

The owner is Sguardi Altrove, a non-profit association with headquarters legal in Milan (MI), Via Cadore 38, 20135 Milan (MI) CF 97194960155, VAT 12940840155.

3. CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

The personal data being processed are those provided by the Data Subject at the time of the establishment of the contractual relationship and also during it. By way

of example and not limitation, the treatment carried out by the Holder could therefore identify CD data (including, for example: first name, last name) contact CD data (email address and telephone number) and information provided within the Project.

4. PERSONAL DATA OF THIRD PARTIES

The Data Subject should communicate personal data relating to third parties, he will be responsible for having provided the necessary information to said third parties and obtained any consents and, where data relating to minors are concerned, for having also legal title for the communication, therefore exempting Sguardi Altrove from any liability and burden towards such subjects.

5. PURPOSES AND LEGAL BASES OF THE PROCESSING

The personal data provided by the Data Subject will be processed for the following purposes:

5.1 management of participation in the Call and the Event:

The personal data of the Participants may be processed by the Owner to manage the participation of interested parties in the Call and possibly in the Event.

The legal basis for the processing carried out for this purpose is the performance of a contract to which the Participant is a party, or the adoption of pre-contractual measures taken at the request thereof pursuant to Article 6 of the GDPR.

The provision of the personal data of the Data Subject is of a mandatory nature and any refusal will make it impossible for Sguardi Altrove to allow its participation in the Call and the Event.

5.2 In case of winning: management of the Award award and sending of communications of service

The personal data of the Participants, in case of victory, may be processed by the Owner to manage the award of the Prize provided for within the Regulations and send the related service communications.

The provision of the personal data of the Data Subject is of a mandatory nature and its possible refusal will make it impossible for Sguardi Altrove to award any Prize.

5.3 Owner's right of defense:

The personal data provided by the Participants may be processed by the Owner for the protection of the rights of data subjects and the Owner and for the full exercise of their right of defense in both pre-litigation and litigation.

The legal basis for the processing of personal data carried out for the aforementioned purpose is the legitimate interest of the Holder in the defence and exercise of rights, pursuant to Article 6 of the Regulation.

The provision of personal data for the aforementioned purpose is mandatory to ensure the right of defense of the Owner, and failure to confer them will entail the impossibility for interested parties to participate in the Call.

6. PERSONAL DATA STORAGE TIMES

The personal data of the Data Subject will be kept for the time strictly necessary to the achievement of the purposes for which they were collected and in any case no later than 3 years from the end of the Initiative at the end of which they will be definitively cancelled.

7. RECIPIENTS AND PLACE OF PROCESSING

The personal data of the Interested parties may be shared with the subjects defined by the GDPR such as “Recipients”, duly appointed by the Data Controller in charge of processing or Responsible, based on the specific processing activities delegated, i.e.:

- duly appointed employees of the Data Controller responsible for data processing personal, or collaborators and/or consultants of the Owner, duly appointed processors who are committed to confidentiality or have an adequate legal obligation of confidentiality;
- University responsible for awarding prizes, managing the Call and participation in the Event;

- Jury members.

The personal data of the Interested parties are processed in Italian territory or in countries of fact part of the European Economic Area.

8. TREATMENT MODES

The personal data of interested parties may be processed in paper form and with the aid of electronic instruments, with the observance of any appropriate measure to ensure their safety and their confidentiality, with access permitted only to authorized entities, previously appointed as processors or processors, who have follow-up of specific training courses and are periodically updated on the Privacy legislation and sensitized to respect and protection of dignity and confidentiality of data processed in accordance with current laws.

9. THE RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS AND THE METHODS OF EXERCISE

The Privacy Regulation grants each Interested Party the right to exercise the following rights:

- the right to **access** one's personal data as provided for by art.15 of the Regulation;
- the right to obtain the **rectification** or **integration** of one's personal data according to as provided for in art. 16 of the Regulation;
- the right to obtain the **deletion** of one's personal data, as provided for in Article 17 of the Regulation;
- the right to **the portability** of one's personal data, and therefore the right to receive in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format, personal data concerning the Data Subject provided to the Data Controller and to transmit such data personal data to another controller, as provided from art.20 of the Regulation;

- the right to **object** at any time, within the limits of what is provided for by art.21 Regulation, for reasons connected with its own particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning the Data Subject;
- the right to **revoke** each of the consents given at any time, without that this affects the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the said consent prior to revocation pursuant to Article 7 of the Regulation.
